### Registration & On-Campus Housing

Synod Youth Assembly Registration and On-Campus Housing will be in Augustana's air-conditioned [Duane R.] Swanson Commons residence center. Swanson Commons is located at 1010 38<sup>th</sup> Street, Rock Island.\*  
Registration begins at 8:00 a.m.

### Housing Notes

Swanson Commons is a student dormitory and is equipped with basic furnishings to accommodate college students. Therefore, the residence center provides:

- ✓ SHARED BATH with showers (no soap or shampoo provided)
- ✓ NO PILLOWS or BLANKETS (must provide own pillows and blankets)
- ✓ NO FANS, DESK LAMPS, or DRINKING GLASSES (must provide own)
- ✓ NO PERSONAL ROOM SERVICE
- ✓ Beds could possibly be arranged "loft" style in some rooms

Only bed sheets will be available for guests to make their own bed—once again, no pillows or blankets provided. Upon leaving (after the assembly has ended) guests will need to remove bed linens and return them to the Residence Hall desk, along with the room key.

BE SURE to return room key at the end of your stay or Augustana College will assess a fee for a new lock.

(Additional Direction: Swanson Commons can be reached from Centennial Hall by turning east-left-on 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue and turning south-right-on to 38<sup>th</sup> Street at the traffic signal. Travel approximately 1 block. Swanson Commons is on the west-right side of 38<sup>th</sup> Street—across from Lincoln Park's tennis courts.)
