

# UNVEILING THE HEART, RESTORING THE SOUL

**A three Day Retreat within a Twenty-seven Day Process  
for Those in Ministry  
At Manitoumie Retreat Center  
(Located 1 hour and 15 minutes north of Madison, Wisconsin)**

**Monday, May 5 to Wednesday May 7, 2008**

**Cost: \$250.00**

This retreat is open to anyone who is involved in Church ministry whether ordained or non-ordained. There is little doubt that there is deep satisfaction in this work. Less expressed, however, is the spiritual toll suffered by those who take ministry seriously. We can experience depression, shattered dreams of ministry, conflicts at home and in the parish, loneliness, few really close friends, being outwardly active but inwardly depleted, loss of soul, knowing much religion and little spirituality, loss of passion.....

We will create a spiritual community of trust where we can seek the guidance and healing of God in solitude and creative interaction within a beautiful natural setting. We recover our souls.

This **27 day process** will be divided up as follows:

- (1) Participants will be asked to keep a spiritual journal of thoughts, conflicts, dreams, etc through a daily practice for twelve days prior to the retreat;
- (2) The three days of retreat;
- (3) Participants will be asked to imagine and practice a post retreat intention for twelve final days culminating with a check-in with another retreatant.

The retreat will begin on Monday at noon with lunch and conclude Wednesday after lunch.

Retreat Leaders: **Rev. Jim Roberts** (ELCA) has been pastor of Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Rockford, Illinois for 35 years where he has evolved a unique ministry including the practice of Jesus' spirituality, the arts, and urban ministry. He is the author of The Third Species and is presently working on a book on the practice of the spirituality of Jesus. He is a leader in the Creation Spirituality and inter-faith movement and has done retreat work for forty years.

**Rev. Fred Gustafson**, D.Min, (ELCA) has been trained as a pastoral counselor and Jungian Analyst. He practices at the Temenos Counseling Service in Milwaukee and Watertown, Wisconsin. He is the author of The Black Madonna, Dancing Between Two Worlds: Jung and the Native American Soul and editor and contributor to The Moonlit Path: Reflections on the Dark Feminine. For the past twenty-five years he has been involved in the ceremonial and spiritual life and theology of the Lakota Sioux on the Rosebud Reservation in South Dakota.
